

New makes and models are becoming available

By 2040, the sale of all new light duty vehicle sales in BC will be zero emissions as outlined in <u>BC's Zero Emissions Vehicle Act</u>. This legislation is intended to ensure a greater availability of EVs at more affordable prices in BC, as well as provide a regulatory backstop to ensure that the Province's greenhouse gas reduction targets are met.

Automakers all over the world are accelerating their EV launch plans, partly to comply with increasingly stringent emissions regulations in Europe and China. Consumer choice and competitive pricing will be key to attracting new buyers to the EV market.
