SUBJECT: APPEAL PROCESS - IN CAMERA ITEMS OF BUSINESS DATE: July 2, 1991 Revised:

That the general policy with respect to "In Camera" items be continued and that senior staff bring to the attention of Council situations where items should possible be further discussed at a Committee of the Whole meeting before a final decision is made.

Council concurred with the staff recommendation whereby if it is felt there may be public concern with a contemplated action that is being discussed "In Camera", that the decision be tabled or held in abeyance and placed on a Committee of the Whole Agenda for public input. (Discussion arose from concern that most "In Camera" items are not appealable once reported out, as staff have acted on them.)
