- Assists in the preparation of cost estimates for planned and future work and projects.
- Records and maintains a variety of data and information to track operations, and prepares reports using paper and electronic formats.
- Prepares employee performance evaluations for supervisors review.
- Conducts safety risk assessments and assists with the preparation of draft safe work practices.
- Performs other related duties as required.
