Saanich Environmental Awards are an initiative of the Saanich Environment and Natural Areas Advisory Committee (ENAC). The ENAC looks at nominations using the following criteria:

- · Award purpose & eligibility
- Duration/magnitude of effort
- Use of innovation
- · Long-term effects of efforts
- · Significance of efforts
- Past efforts

Award recipients receive a framed certificate awarded at a Saanich Council meeting in June. Recipients' names are also engraved on a permanent plaque at Saanich Municipal Hall.
