



# E-bikes: affordable and climate-friendly transportation

E-bikes make it easy for more people to make more and longer trips by bike.

The District of Saanich is encouraging e-bike riding in place of driving as a climate action.



What they're good for	Cars/ Trucks	E-bikes	Comments
Zips up hills/long distances	✓	✓	E-bikes can go from Saanich to Salt Spring on less than one charge, and can charge at any outlet.
Can carry kids	✓	✓	Kids ages 1-11 can generally be transported by e-bike. Babies and older kids need other options.
Can carry groceries and other heavy items	✓	✓	You'd be surprised what you can carry, especially in a cargo e-bike or with a bike trailer.
Exercise and fresh air	✗	✓	E-bikes provide different levels of assist, so you can get as much or as little exercise as you want.
Climate-friendly	✗	✓	E-bikes use fewer materials to build and less energy to operate than gas or electric cars, and have zero greenhouse gas emissions when operated.
