Introduction



Here are two easy ways to find an address in SaanichMap. The first is “Global Search Tool” and the second is “Find by Address”. They both allow you to quickly zoom to a specific known address and view its details.

1. Global Search for Address





Start typing the address in the Global Search window on the top right of the page. When the desired address appears in the pick list, click on it.

A panel will open on the left. The matching results will typically show a locator link and parcel link. Clicking on either will zoom you to the location on the map however the parcel link will also provide property details.



2. Find by Address Tool


In the “I want to...” menu, select the “Find by Address” tool.





The “Find by Address” panel will appear. Start typing the address you would like to find on the map. When the desired address appears in the pick list, click on it and click on “Submit”.

The address will appear in the left panel and the map will automatically zoom to and highlight the property.

If the address contains multiple units, they will be listed as well.



To view details for a property, simply click on the name in the left panel.
