SUBJECT: APPEAL PROCEDURES	DATE: September 9, 1996
	REFERENCE: 96/CW

Pursuant to the Council Procedure Bylaw, persons wishing to appeal a Council or Committee of the Whole decision shall advise the Municipal Clerk either orally or in writing at least six days in advance of the subject meeting. The appeal must be heard by Council within thirty days of the decision being made.

The weekly Notice of Meetings shall include notice of specific appeals and the appeal will be included on the written agenda.
