Council has adopted the following policy in order to recognize the heritage value and architectural and artistic significance of the Municipal Hall.

- 1. The architectural features and fabric of the building should be recognized, celebrated and preserved. No attachments should be made to exposed concrete murals or fluted concrete columns. Items attached to existing concrete murals should be removed over time and damage repaired.
- 2. Signage should be coordinated and harmonized throughout the public areas of the municipal hall.
- 3. Artworks and displays should be presented in a professional manner with less staff effort required.
- 4. Public and staff areas should be adequately separated from each other with each use clearly marked.
