SUBJECT: SUBDIVISION APPLICATIONS - MINIMUM ROAD FRONTAGE

REQUIREMENT

In January, 1995 the Subdivision Bylaw was amended to reinstate Council's authority to grant relaxation of the 10 percent road frontage requirement pursuant to the <u>Municipal Act</u>. Therefore, all applications requesting a relaxation of this frontage requirement must be processed to Council for approval.

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In July, 1999 the Subdivision Bylaw was further amended to give the Approving Officer the authority to exempt non-panhandle lots which do not meet the 10 percent road frontage requirement pursuant to the <u>Municipal Act</u>. Therefore, only those subdivision applications involving a panhandle lot requesting a relaxation of this frontage requirement must be processed to Council for approval.
