CONTINUED REVIEW OF THE HEALTHY SAANICH COMMUNITY WORKSHOP DOCUMENT-HOUSING AND OTHER SECTIONS

The Chair facilitated a committee discussion and the following was noted:

- Supporting working partnerships with other groups/organizations to increase the number of affordable housing units.
- Ensure the updated Local Area Plans have a reference to affordable housing.
- Diverse affordable housing options that maintain public green space would be desirable.
- Involve Community Associations to assist with the development of affordable housing that address specific needs in their communities.
- Community collaboration to help ensure community support.
- The Municipality can support affordable housing by amending current zoning bylaws that allow for the construction and/or addition of affordable housing units.
- The Municipality could support a variety of housing options. For example, allowing rooming houses in the University of Victoria area.
- Provide support for aging homeowners to remain in their homes.
- A significant challenge to affordable housing is the high cost of land.
- Planning Staff will be invited to a future HSAC meeting to help committee members understand affordable housing from the perspective of the Saanich Planning Department.
- Lane-way housing could be considered for larger lot properties within Saanich.
- Encourage more infill housing.

MOTION: Moved by M. Henderson and seconded by J. Fraser: "That the Healthy Saanich Advisory Committee;

- a. Encourages Council to support creative ways of providing a variety of affordable housing options that support a broad range of citizens; and,
- b. Recommends that when the Planning Department reviews the Local Area Plans the Planning Department include affordable housing considerations."
