Job Purpose

- Ensures that no hazardous waste or other restricted material is dropped off at the drop off site.
- Screens vehicles for residency and issues identification stickers.
- Maintains brochures, pamphlets and other material for hand out to the public.
- Performs manual work such as sweeping, shovelling, traffic control and clean-up.
- Performs cart maintenance including washing, assembly, staging and storage.
- Operates the backhoe to maintain the drop off site.
- Daily and monthly site safety inspections.
- Performs other related duties as required.
