Job Purpose

Performs manual work entailing considerable physical effort and agility in the performance of a variety of manual maintenance tasks during municipal building shutdowns, pre/post renovation work and emergency or disaster response.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Cleans and scrubs a variety of surfaces such as railings, walls, showers, pool surfaces, kick plates and other components of the building.
- Assists in the replacement of chemical lines and cleaning of chemical storage containers.
- Grouts and tiles.
- Assists in the stripping and waxing of slides.
- Cleans windows inside and out, includes low level ladder work.
- Power washes interior and exterior surfaces.
- Cleans and maintains a variety of facility fixtures including but not limited to pool amenities and fitness equipment.
- Sweeps, scrubs, strips, seals and waxes and polishes floors.
- Moves office furniture and equipment as required.
- Performs lifting of equipment and supplies.
- Performs other related duties as required.
