Job Purpose

Assists in the coordination of and performs trades work requiring skill and ability at the journey level in the application of a variety of operational tasks associated with horticulture and turf maintenance programs. Duties include tasks which require specialized training common to the horticulture and turf maintenance trade.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Performs a wide variety of horticultural and turf maintenance tasks, such as: planting, pruning, watering, propagation, edging, mowing, design and planning, general plant health care, integrated pest management and irrigation (minor repairs and programming) for turf and a variety of native and non-native tree and plant species.
- Provides direction, training and guidance to other staff, contractors and hired equipment in the daily onsite work for all technical aspects of horticultural and turf management programs and projects.
- Assists in the coordination and implementation of horticulture and turf maintenance programs including major renovation projects.
- Operates and performs service maintenance on a wide variety of manual and motorized tools and equipment pertinent to horticulture and turf maintenance.
- Assists in work planning for assigned areas, projects and programs and assists in scheduling of crews and equipment.
- Inspects turf and plants and develops recommended treatments
- Implements turf and plant maintenance programs including major renovation projects.
- Maintains work-related records electronically and manually.
- Creates and interprets site plans and underground utility checks for horticultural related projects.
- Ensures the safety of work crews and the public by enforcing all appropriate Municipal and Worksafe BC regulations.
- Assists in identifying requirements of labour, equipment and materials in preparation of estimates for projects.
- Performs other related duties as required.

Qualifications

- Grade 12 or equivalent.
- Certificate of Qualification and Certificate of Apprenticeship in Horticulture **or** a recognized Horticultural Diploma from a recognized post-secondary institution.
- Four years including Apprenticeship of progressive experience and providing direction to others in a horticulture or turf maintenance related position.
- BC Pesticide Applicator's Certificate.
- An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Valid Class 5 BC Driver's Licence.
