Saanich Parks is seeking the participation of neighbourhood organizations and residents to partner with The District to increase the number of trees planted on the boulevards within our neighbourhoods and to increase our Urban Forest Canopy.

Tree Selection Process:

Committed to the principle of planting the right tree for the right place, we work with residents and the local nurseries to ensure there is an adequate selection of small, medium and large tree species that are readily available for this program. Timely tree selection by the homeowner is important to secure the best available tree stock for the planting season that runs from October – March depending on weather.

- Tree Species: You will need three (3) preferences and we will attempt to get you your 1st choice based on Nursery inventory and availability. Add your selections to the space provided on the front page.

- ✓ <u>Tree Location:</u> Assist us by providing as much information about your preferred tree site.
 - > Drawing a map of the potential tree location. (In the space provided on the front page)
 - Possible issues that we need to be aware of: Shared property lines, fire hydrant, traffic signs, overhead lines, hydro pole or lamp standard, irrigation lines in lawn.
