NOTICE OF WAIVER OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the District of Saanich pursuant to Section 464 (2) of the *Local Government Act* has waived the holding of a Public Hearing in relation to proposed Zoning Bylaw, 2003, Amendment Bylaw, 2020, No. 9627 (“Bylaw 9627”). The purpose of Bylaw 9627 is to implement requirements for the installation of electric vehicle charging infrastructure in all new developments, to come into effect on September 1, 2020.

Saanich Council will consider Third Reading of Bylaw 9627 at a Special Council meeting scheduled for **MONDAY, AUGUST 10, 2020 AT 7:00 PM in the SAANICH MUNICIPAL HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS**, 770 Vernon Avenue, Victoria, BC, V8X 2W7.

As per the Order of the Minister of Public Safety and Solicitor General, *Emergency Program Act*, Ministerial Order No. M192, public attendance at the meeting is not required if it cannot be accommodated in accordance with the applicable requirements or recommendations under the Public Health Act.
