NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to Section 464(2) of the *Local Government Act*, as amended by the *Municipal Affairs Statutes Amendment Act (No. 2), 2021*, the District of Saanich **will not be holding** a public hearing in relation to the following proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING will be held in the SAANICH MUNICIPAL HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 770 Vernon Avenue, Victoria, BC, V8X 2W7, on **MONDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2023, at 7:00 P.M.**, to allow the public to make verbal or written representation to Council with respect to the following proposed permit and bylaw.


A. TEMPORARY USE PERMIT APPLICATION ON MCKENZIE AVENUE

The intent of this application is for a Temporary Use Permit for three years at Lot 1, Section 32, Victoria District, Plan 27719 (**1359 MCKENZIE AVENUE**) – specifically, Braefoot Park’s lacrosse box, to allow for the sale of Christmas trees subject to the conditions outlined within the permit.

B. ZONING BYLAW, 2003, AMENDMENT BYLAW, 2023, NO. 9964 PROPOSED NEW P-4RV (RECREATION, OPEN SPACE AND RECREATION VEHICLE STORAGE) ZONE PROPOSED REZONING AT 450 CREED ROAD FOR STORAGE OF UNOCCUPIED RECREATION VEHICLES, BOATS, AND TRAILERS

The intent of this bylaw is to create a new P-4RV (Recreation, Open Space and Recreation Vehicle Storage) Zone, which is similar to the P-4 (Recreation and Open Space) Zone but, in addition, permits unenclosed storage of unoccupied recreation vehicles, boats and trailers. Also, this bylaw rezones Lot A, Section 19, Lake District, and Section 3, Range 0, West Highland District, Plan VIP78109 (**450 CREED ROAD**) from the P-4 (Recreation and Open Space) Zone to the P-4RV (Recreation, Open Space and Recreation Vehicle Storage Zone) to allow continued use of a designated area of the site for the unenclosed storage of unoccupied recreation vehicles, boats and trailers.

The proposed permit and bylaw may be inspected, and further information may be obtained from the Legislative Services Division, Saanich Municipal Hall, 770 Vernon Avenue, from October 26, 2023, onwards. The report, copy of the proposed permit and agenda package will be available for viewing on the Saanich website on Thursday, November 2, 2023, at Saanich.ca/agendas.
