## **PROCLAMATION**

## PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS MONTH SEPTEMBER, 2017

WHEREAS: prostate cancer is the most common cancer to affect Canadian men; and

WHEREAS: 1 to 7 Canadian men will be diagnosed with the disease in his lifetime; and

WHEREAS: an estimated 24,000 Canadian men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer this

year, and

WHEREAS: the survival rate for prostate cancer can be over 90% when detected early; and

WHEREAS: those with a family history of the disease, or those of African or Caribbean

descent, are at a greater risk of developing prostate cancer; and

WHEREAS: Prostate Cancer Canada recommends that men get a PSA test in their 40s to

establish their baseline;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Richard Atwell, Mayor of the Corporation of the District of

Saanich, proclaim the month of September as Prostate Cancer

Awareness Month.
