

How to Load the Grange Google Earth File


Download the 'Grange Google Earth.kmz' file from the Saanich Current Projects website and save it to your computer:

(this isn't here yet, use local file)


Navigate to the Google Earth Web browser:

<https://earth.google.com/web>


Click on the 'New' button on the left side of the page:




Click on the 'Import' button under Local KML file:




Navigate to the folder where you saved the 'Grange Google Earth.kmz' file and click open:




'Grange Google Earth' is now loaded as a local file and appears in the left menu. Click the drop-down arrow next to 'Grange Google Earth':



Click on the three dots next to 'Model':




Click 'Fly to':




Click and hold the **left mouse button** to **move** around the map.

Scroll the **middle mouse wheel** up and down to **zoom** in and out on the map.


Click and hold the **middle mouse wheel** button to **rotate** the map around in 3D space.




To change to 2D, click the 'Layers' button near the bottom left of the map:




Under 'Additional layers', click the toggle to turn off the '3D buildings' layer:



Click the '2D' button on the bottom right of the screen:



Pan, zoom, and scroll through the project site.



To change back to 3D, click the '3D' button and turn the '3D buildings' layer back on.
