Supply List:

• 3 painting supports:

One 8x10" canvas paper or canvas board, one 11x14" or 12x16", one large canvas i.e. 18x24"

Paint: (water soluble oil or acrylic)

- Ultramarine Blue
- Azo Yellow Middle or Cadmium Middle
- Alizarin Crimson
- Burnt Umber
- Titanium White
- Yellow Ochre *
- Phthalo Blue*
- Quinacridone Red*
- Burnt Sienna*
- Lemon Yellow*

Brushes:

To be discussed in class, basically a small, medium and large brush. Size 2, 6, 10 approximately. It may be nice to have a flat, a round, and a filbert shaped. Palette knife is optional.

Palette:

For oils: A large airtight plastic container with a lid, (think of a flattish rubbermaid container) or a large piece of stiff cardboard with several layers of wax paper attached.

For acrylics: An airtight plastic container as described above, or a stay wet palette. These are expensive and not necessary but might be nice to have if you continue on your painting journey!

- For oil paints: Linseed oil, small jar with lid for oil storage
- For acrylic paints: Small spray bottle
- Rag for wiping your brush. Oily rags must be spread to dry at home after use.
