#### Supply List:

Acrylic or water-soluble oil paints in these colours:

- Titanium White (large tube)
- Cadmium Red Medium
- Alizarin Crimson
- Hansa or Cadmium Yellow Medium
- Lemon Yellow Cadmium Yellow Light
- Phthalo Blue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Burnt Umber

Please Note: If you already have paint, please just bring it along! All that is required is a "cool" version and a "warm" version of each primary colour. Think Lemons and School buses (yellow), cherries and strawberries(red) , and tropical ocean and blueberries (Blue).

- For oils: water-soluble linseed oil
- For acrylics: gloss medium, just to thin the paint a bit. A small amount of water will also work in this case.
- Supports for acrylics and oils: canvas paper of any size. Make sure that it is primed, not raw canvas. At least 6 sheets of 9"x12" paper. Please see note below

Another note: My intention is that you will end the class with a **notebook made of canvas paper** to refer to when colour mixing questions arise!

- Palette - appropriate to medium used (freezer paper works great for acrylics and oils)
- Round and flat brushes in various sizes - appropriate to medium used
- Palette knife (acrylics and oils)
- Spray bottle
- Painting rags
- Barrier hand cream (optional)
- Apron/painting shirt (optional)
- Subject matter ideas – photos or sketches
