Public Skating Rules of Conduct

For your enjoyment and safety during Public Skates, please follow the rules listed below

Admission and Skate Rentals: Please pay at reception and receive proof of payment to hand to the skate attendant.

Equipment:

Skates: All skaters must be wearing skates. NO shoes permitted.

<u>Helmets</u>: Helmets are strongly recommended. Pearkes has helmets to use, first come, first served.

Clothing: Dress appropriately for your safety and enjoyment.

Entering the Ice: Please do not enter the ice until the skate attendant opens the gate to the ice surface. Please leave the ice when instructed by the skate attendant.

Skating Aids: Skating aids must stay in the beginner area. Please do not misuse the skating aids. Please do not carry children at any time.

Wheelchairs and Strollers: If you are pushing a device you must be wearing skates. Helmets are strongly recommended. Do not leave an occupied device unattended.

Games and Activities: When permitted the skate attendant will organize fun on ice activities.

Skate Attendant: The skate attendant is present for your safety. Report any concerns, accidents or injuries immediately.

Food & Drink: Food or drinks are not permitted on the ice surface.

Coaching: Outside coaching is not permitted on public skating sessions.

While on the Ice: All skaters must skate in the same direction. Respect all skill levels & abilities. There is no sitting on the boards, no entry to the players or penalty boxes. For rest periods please use the seating in the lobby.

Use of cell phone: Do not text while skating. If using a headset, please keep volume down and be aware of your surroundings. If you take a photo, no other patrons can be in the photo.

In case of an emergency: Please listen for direction from the skate attendant or facility staff.

Your belongings: GR Pearkes is not responsible for your belongings. See reception to lock up your belongings in one of the public lockers located in the lobby.

Your Skating Experience: We respect you, please respect our staff. We strive to create a positive experience and a safe environment. We will not tolerate harassment, verbal abuse or violence towards our staff.
