

# Horner Park – Summary of Feedback Received

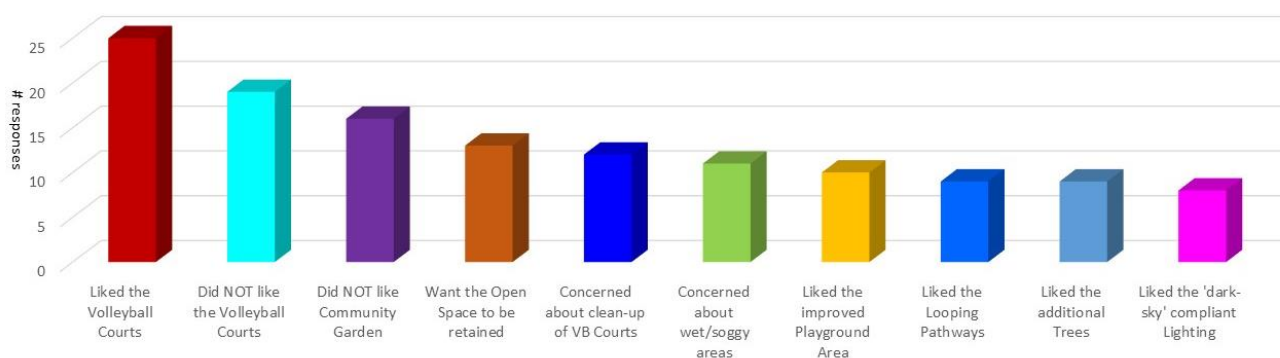
(Feb 14 – Apr 6, 2020)

Thanks to the **76 individuals** who wrote emails and letters to us about the Proposed Concept Plan for Horner Park.

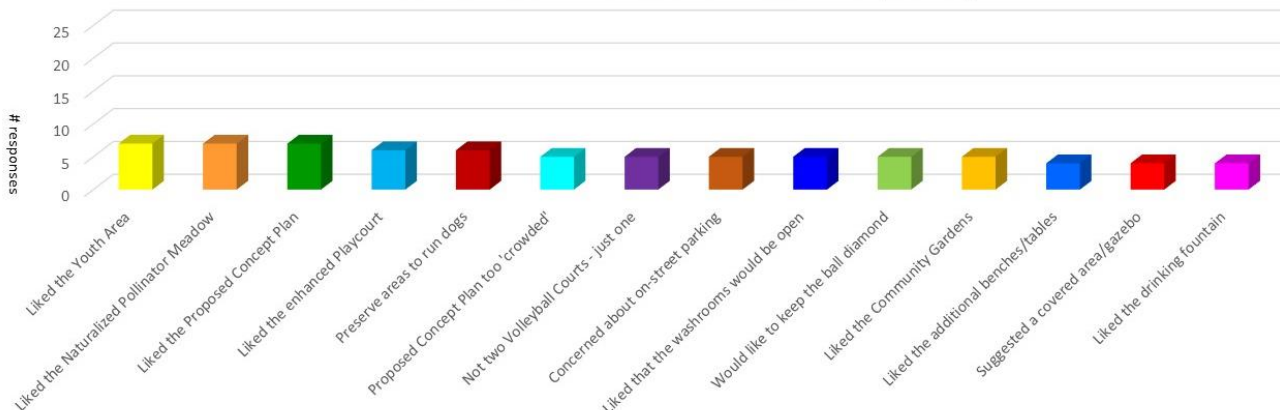

What was commented on most frequently

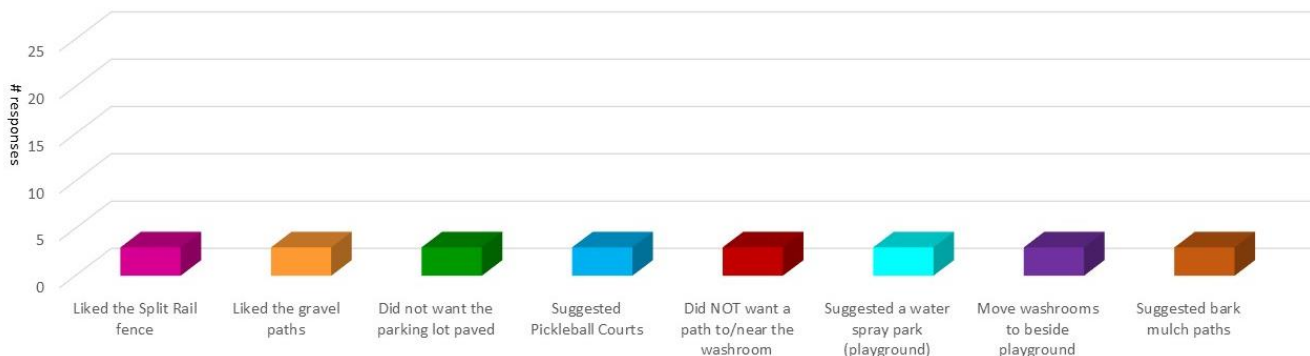


What was commented on less frequently



## What was also mentioned but not as frequently?

This is a list of what was mentioned by only one or two people:

- Proposed that this neighbourhood have 'Residential Only' parking
- Fully fence the south side of the park with chain-link
- Appreciate the communication with parks and the posting of the plans in the park
- Have a fence around the volleyball courts to prevent cats from entering the space and separate from the Playcourt
- Concerned that the community anecdotal surveys were not reliable enough to base plans on
- Do not want the washrooms open.
- Open washrooms from dawn till dusk not from 7am to 11pm – for safety and minimize disturbance to neighbours.
- Do not like the looping trails
- Do not have any asphalt trails
- Make all the trails asphalt so young kids can scooter and tricycle around
- Do not make improvements to the parking lot
- Concerned about the removal of the blackberry bushes to allow for parking lot improvements
- Ensure runoff from the amenities recharge the aquifer
- Have fruit bearing trees (apple etc.) and shrubs in the Pollinator Meadow
- Add stage so that performances can be held in the park
- Do not allow dogs (leash or no leash) into the playground area
- Add more signs asking dog owners to pick up after their dogs
- Add lighting at all park entrances and throughout the park
- Appreciate the two community art
- Have garbage bins at each entrance to the park
- Add a tennis court
- Have irrigation to all new trees
- Add pitching mounds to enhance the ball diamond
- Do not have an area for the Bocce court
- Appreciate the flat area for Bocce
- Do not have the Naturalized Pollinator Meadow as it will look messy
- Include a naturalized area with a creek and a pond
- Make the gravel path a 'sand' colour as it will look better.
- Do not have the gap in the fence and path leading to playground from Iona
