
Working for the Watershed



Big Transformation

Historically, the Douglas Creek watershed was Douglas-fir forest and Garry Oak meadows and part of the traditional territories of Indigenous people. In the late 1800s, during the settlement era of Victoria and British Columbia, much of the land was cleared for farmland. The area was largely agricultural until the 1950s, when the land was developed for housing. Today, the watershed is almost entirely residential, with some commercial development along the Shelbourne Street corridor, and several small parks.
