Brydon Park is named after the first Reeve (Mayor) of Saanich, Thomas Brydon. Mr. Brydon owned a farm in the area named Craigo Park Farm.

The park features open space with a playground and sports court.

The Saanich Tennis Club operates the courts adjacent to the park. They are available for public use during limited hours.

Dogs may be off leash, but under control at all times.

Dogs are not permitted on sport courts or playgrounds and must be leashed within 10m of the playground.
