About the Park:



The Colquitz River runs through this forested park. A variety of animals live here, including owls, woodpeckers, herons, salmon, and otters. Be sure to visit the fish fence during the salmon run!

Dogs must be on a leash at all times, except on designated leash optional trails (see map)



The river is protected, and we remind people to keep, boats, dogs and themselves out of the water to protect the natural environment. Only use formal trails – this reduces impacts to the park including the spread of plants and invasive species across the area.

The estuary is part of the Victoria Harbour Migratory Bird Sanctuary (VHMBS). Visitors should be aware that specific rules and regulations apply to this waterway, including some that pertain to dogs.
