About the Park:

This park was once the site of a village, which was home to the Lekwungen people. The Lekwungen eventually became known as the Songhees and spoke the Northern Straits language, a linguistic division of the Salish language family. The name “Kwatsech” is the Songhees name for Gordon Head. This is a municipal park with trails leading to the serene coves and rocky outcrops facing Haro Strait. Pedestrian access is from both Gordon Point Drive and Shore Way.



Dogs must be on leash at all times.

Beach is leash optional.
