## About the Park:

This compact waterfront park is full of opportunities. The interpretive sign provides a brief history of the McMorran family in Cordova Bay. We recognize that this is just one part of the park's story, and we are working with local Indigenous

communities to ensure their rich history and ongoing presence in the area are better reflected in future signage and interpretation. The pathway leading to the beach and the grassy area has hosted

numerous weddings and festivities. To book the park for a wedding or other event, contact Saanich Parks via email or phone to secure a park permit.

Dogs must be on a leash at all times in the park, except between the hours of 6am and 9am, when they are permitted to be off-leash, but remain under control.

Dogs not permitted on beach during the months of May through August between Cordova Bay Beach & Walema Avenue EXCEPT before 9:00 a.m.
