About the Park:

Outerbridge Park entrance is adjacent to 1181 Royal Oak Drive. The park has a number of features including trails,

ponds and bridges and is a sanctuary for wildlife, particularly birds, in a setting that people can also enjoy. Some areas of the property are planted with ornamental plants and others have been left in a natural state. Saanich Parks partners with the Horticulture Centre of the Pacific (HCP) for the ongoing operation of the park. Mrs. Outerbridge's vision is alive and well by the hard work of dedicated volunteers and HCP horticulture students.

Dogs must be on a leash at all times, except between the hours of 6am and 9am, when they are permitted to be off-leash, but under control.
