
The park, originally named Christmas Hill Park, was renamed Vic Derman Park in 2017 to honour the late Saanich Councillor who served our community from 2002 to 2017. Vic Derman was an avid cyclist and tireless community advocate who championed many causes relating to sustainability, climate change mitigation, smart growth and livable, affordable communities.

Dogs must be on a leash at all times, except between the hours of 6am and 9am, when they are permitted to be offleash, but under control.
