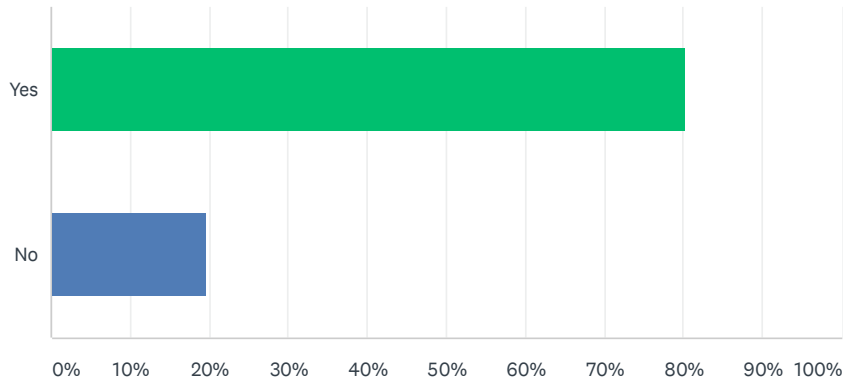

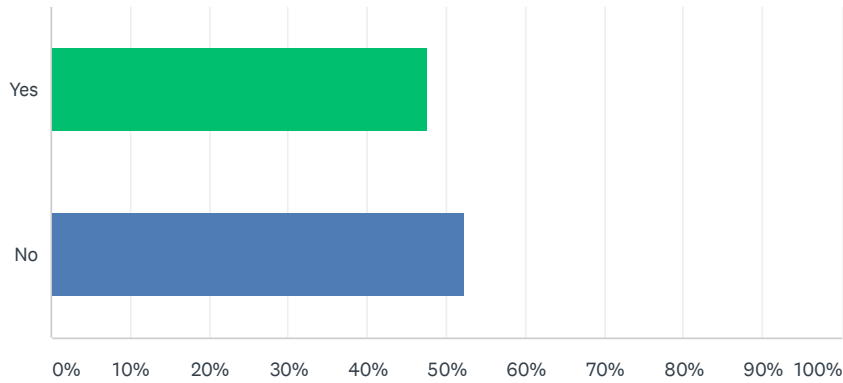

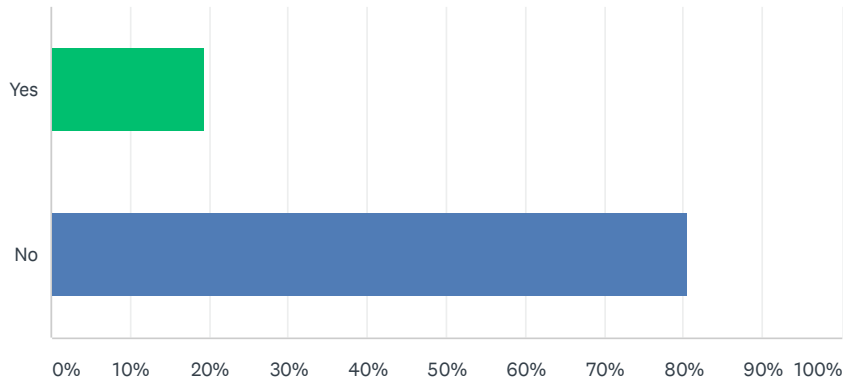

### Q3 Do you skateboard?

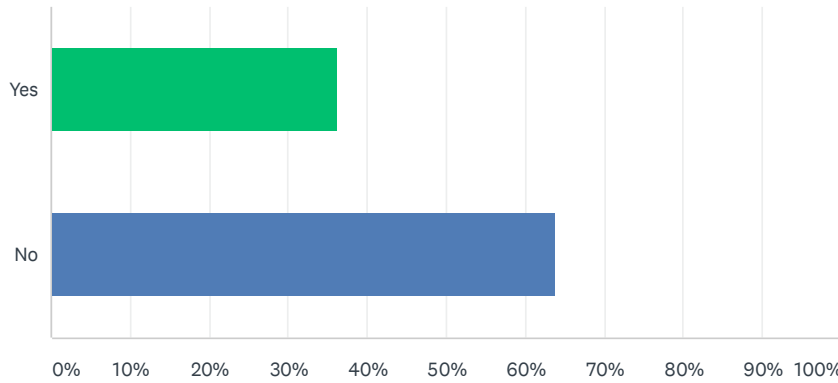

### Q4 Do you like Parkour?

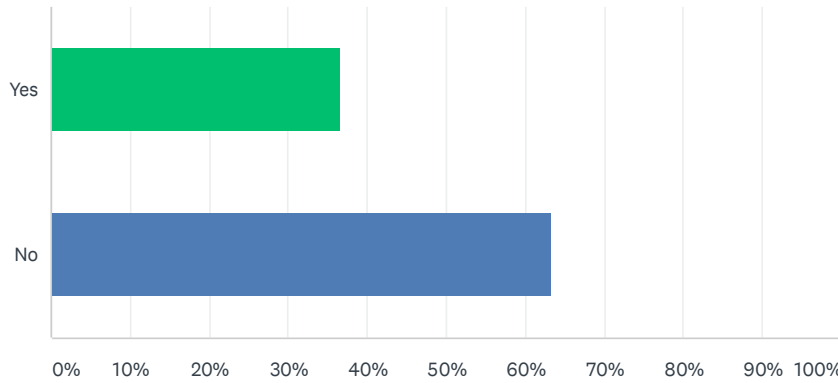

### Q5 Are you into Street Art?

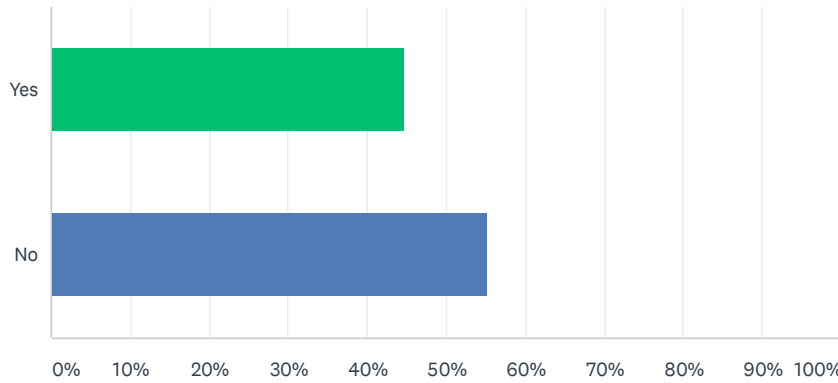

### Q6 Are you into Performing Arts?

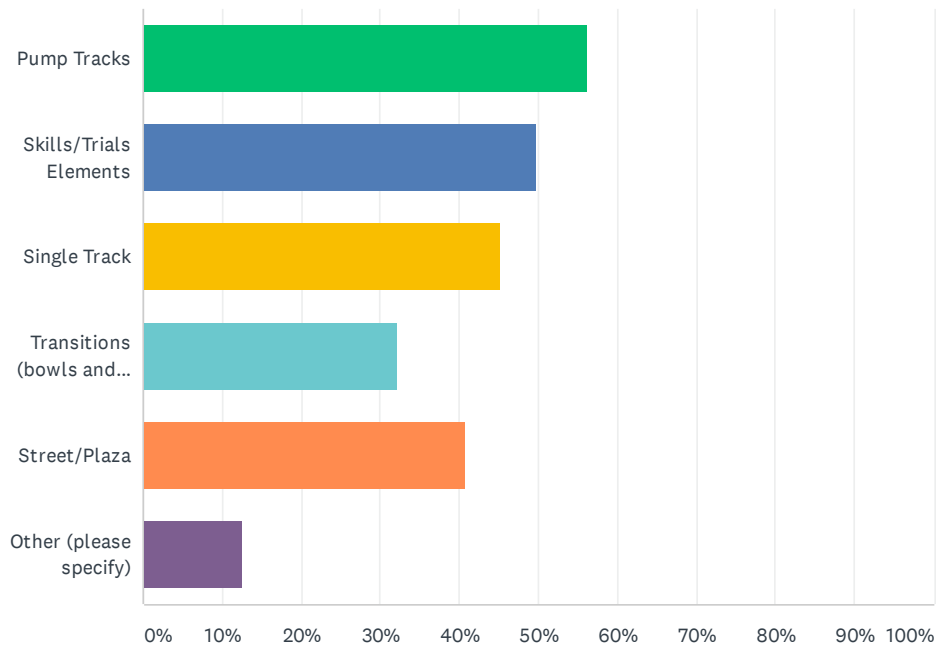

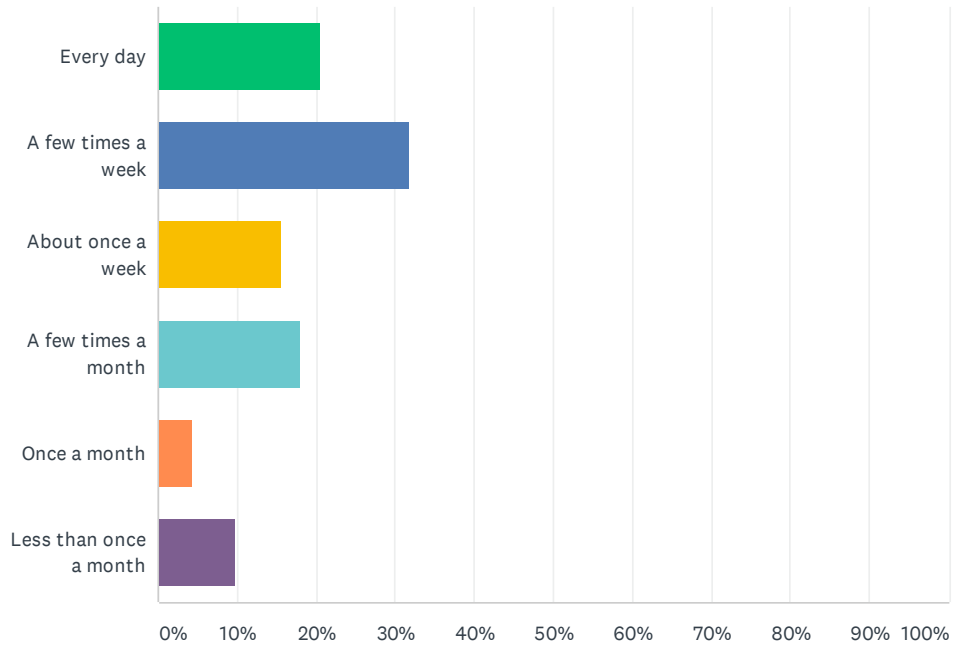

### Q8 How often do you ride?

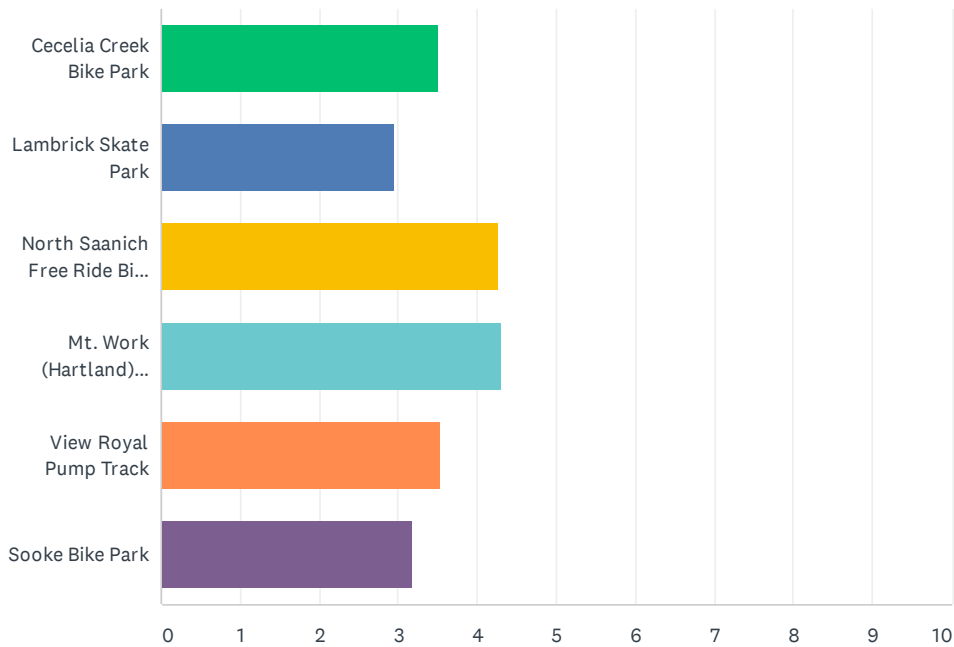

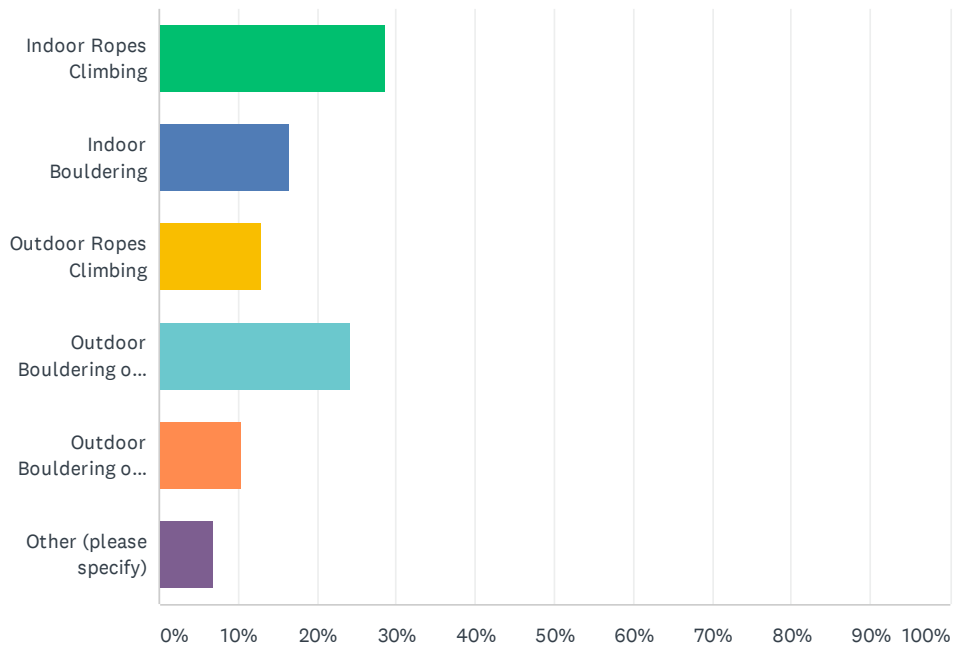

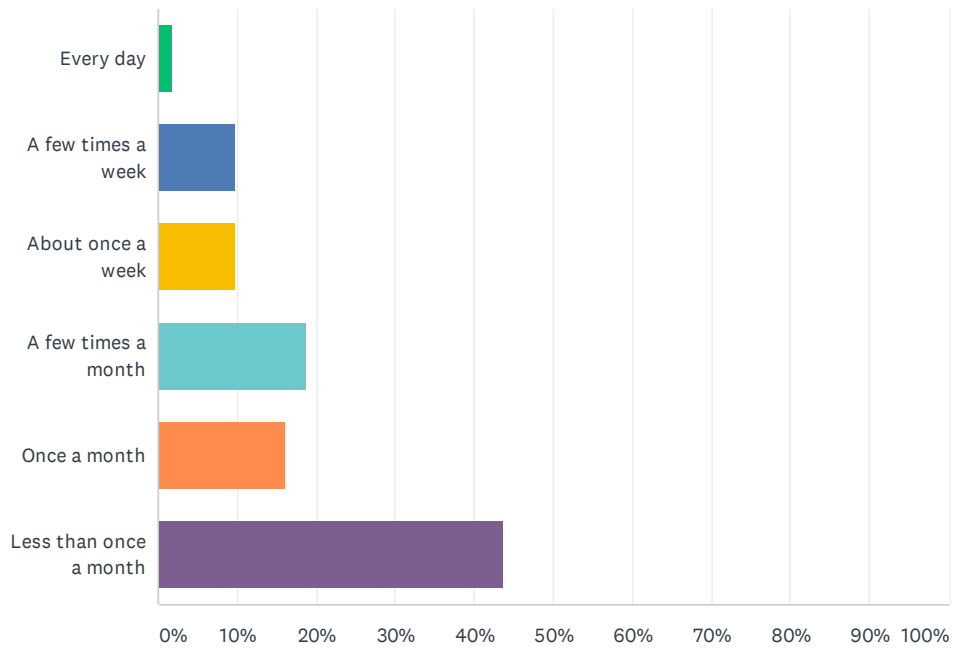

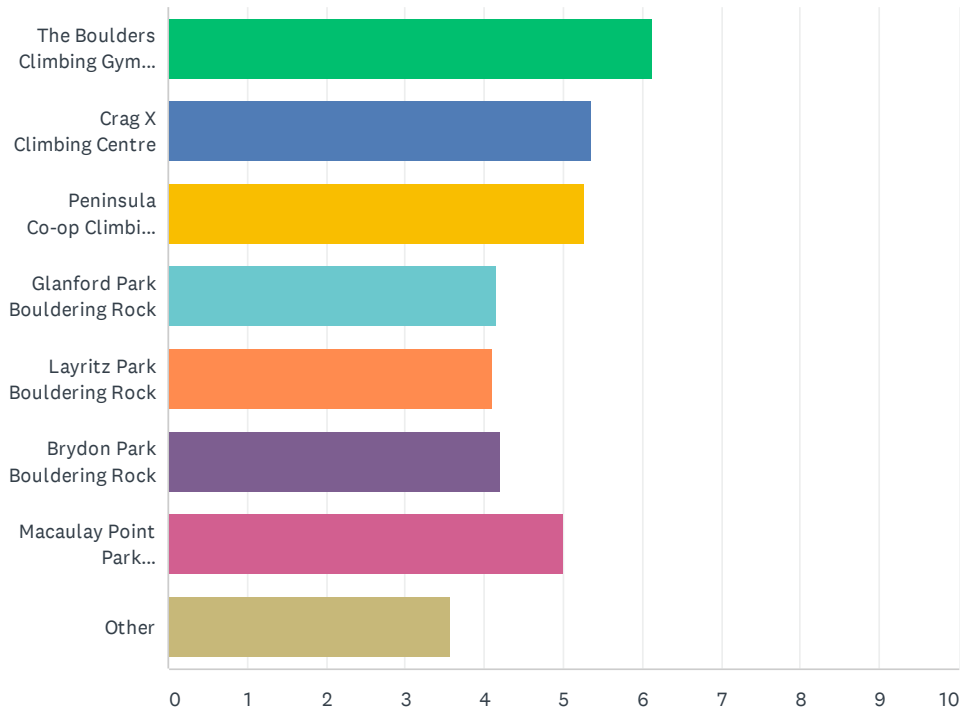

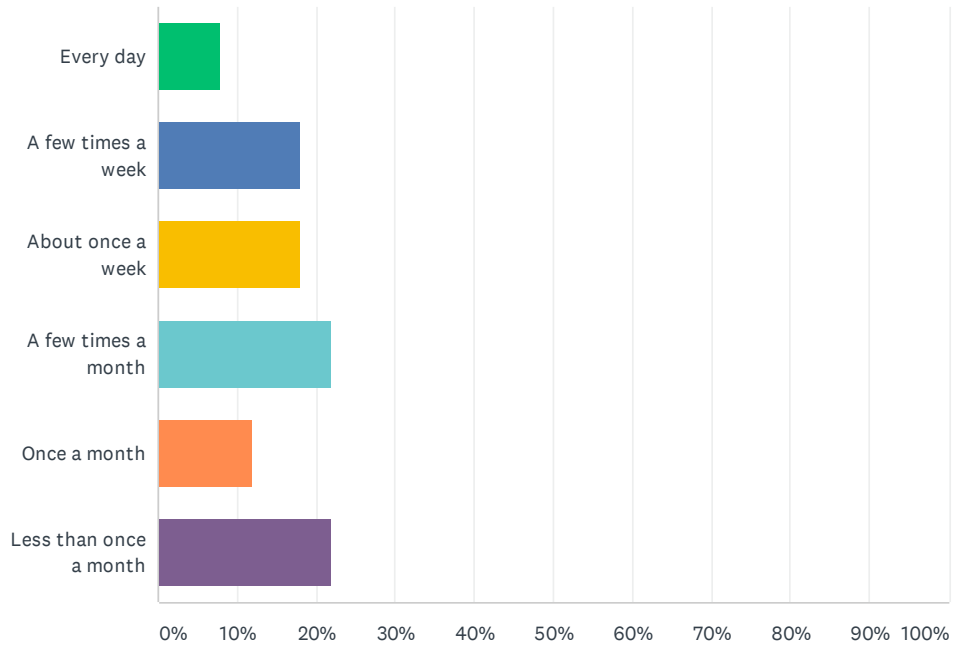

### Q19 How often do you skate?

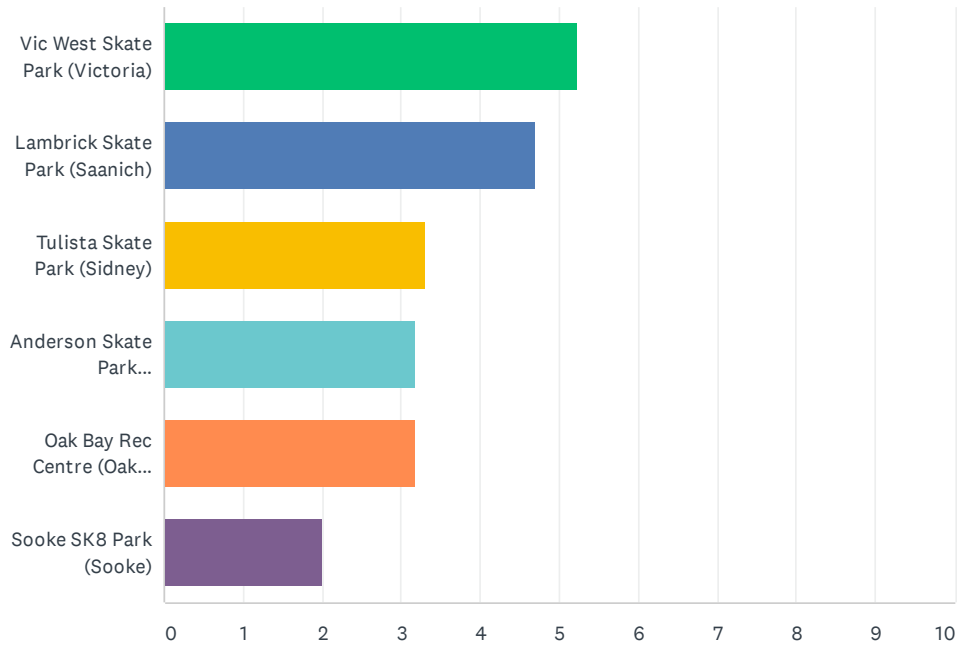

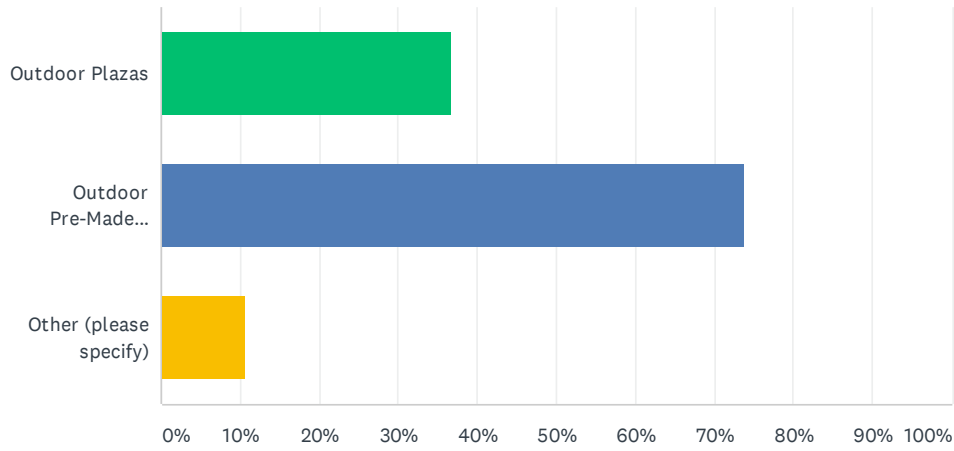

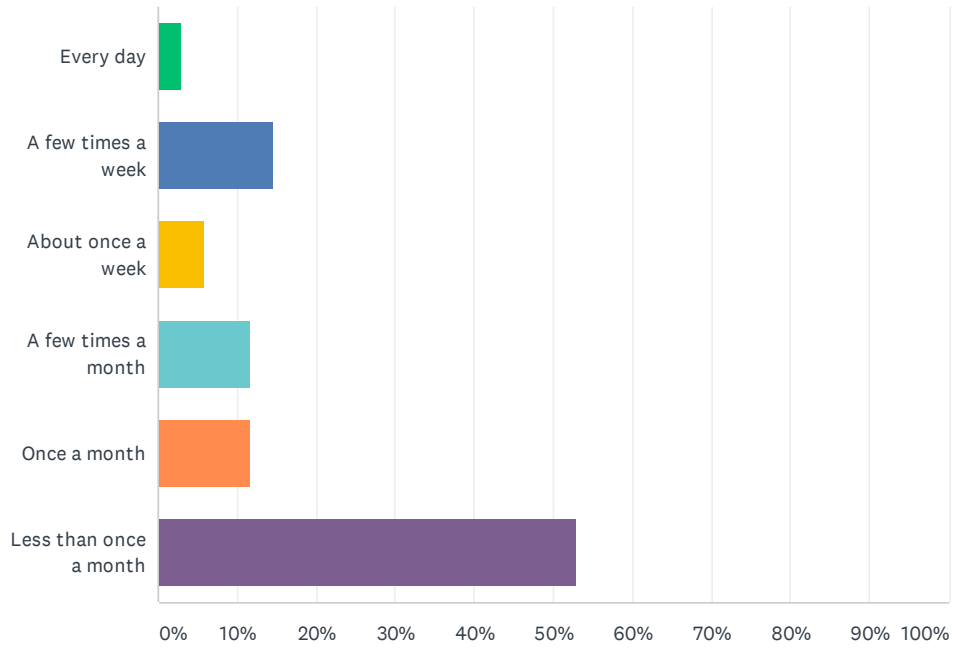

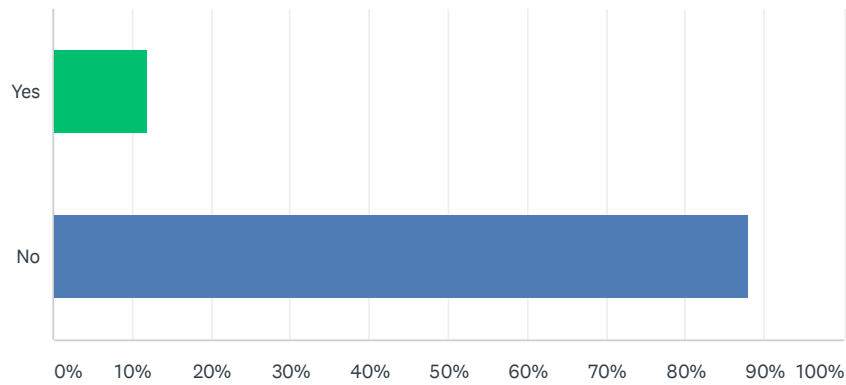

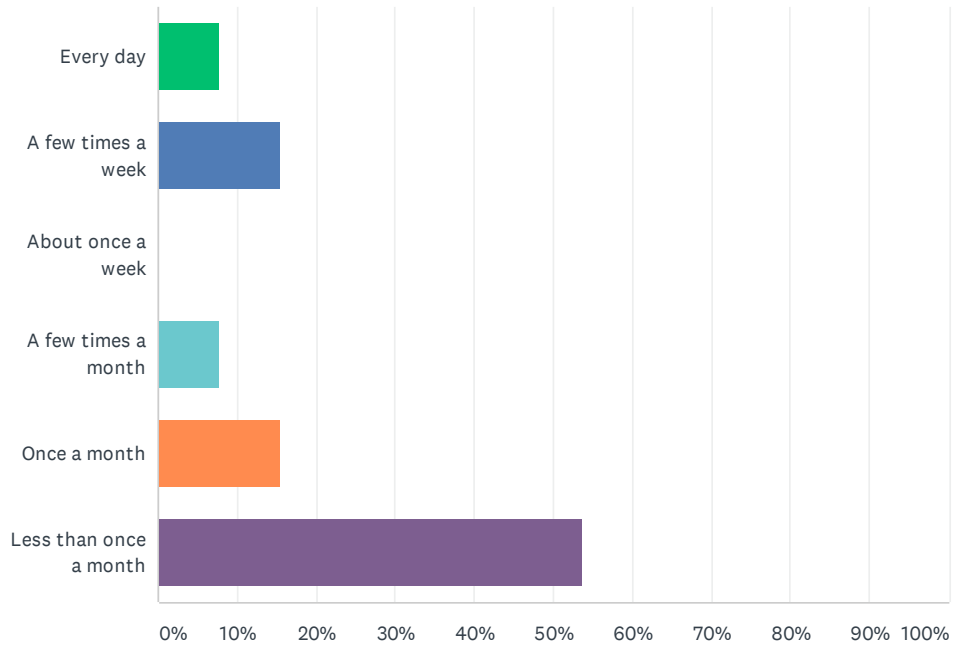

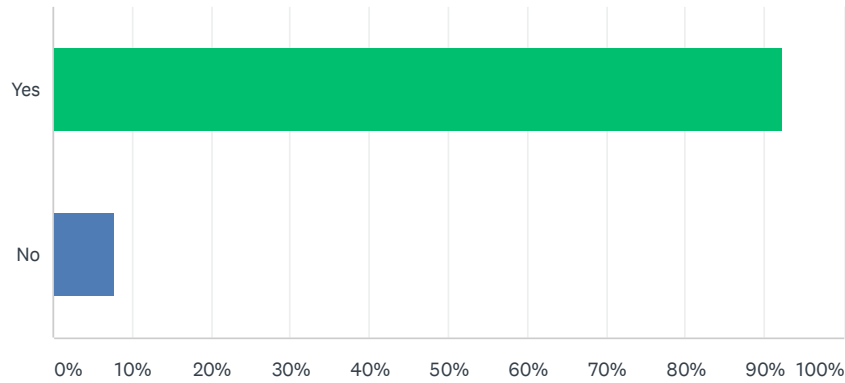

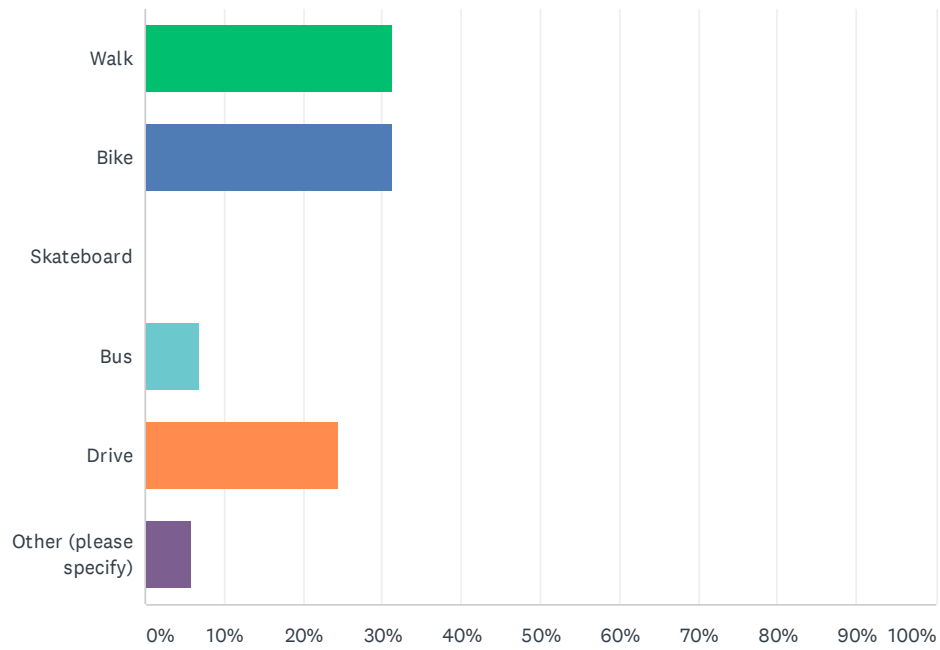

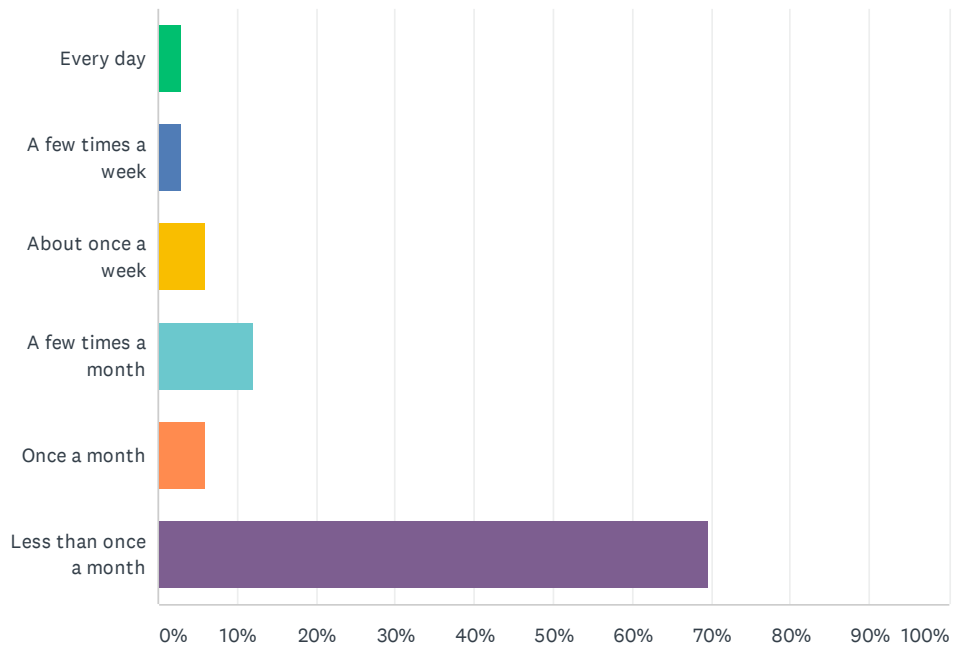

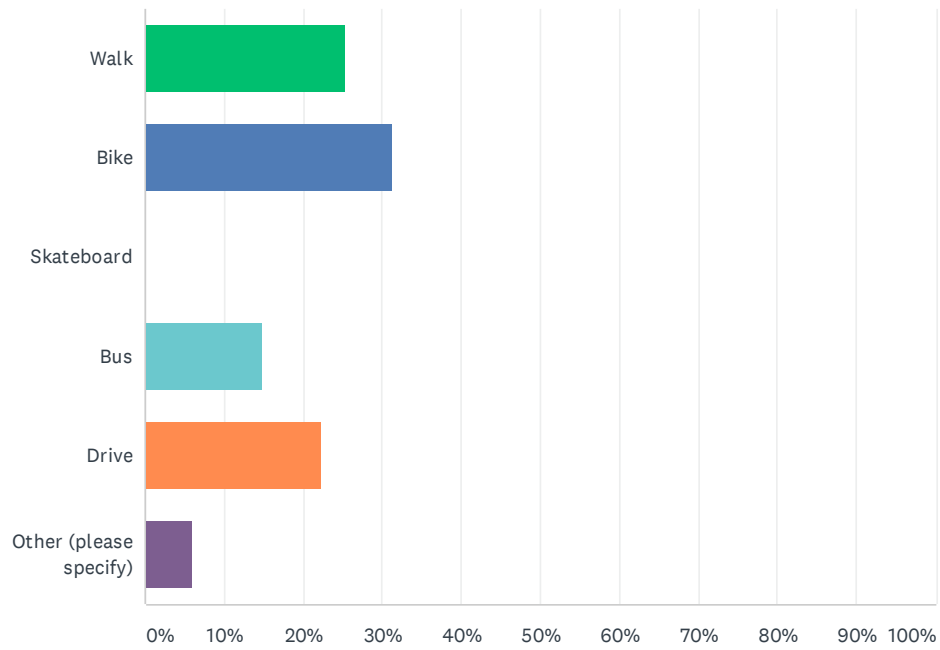

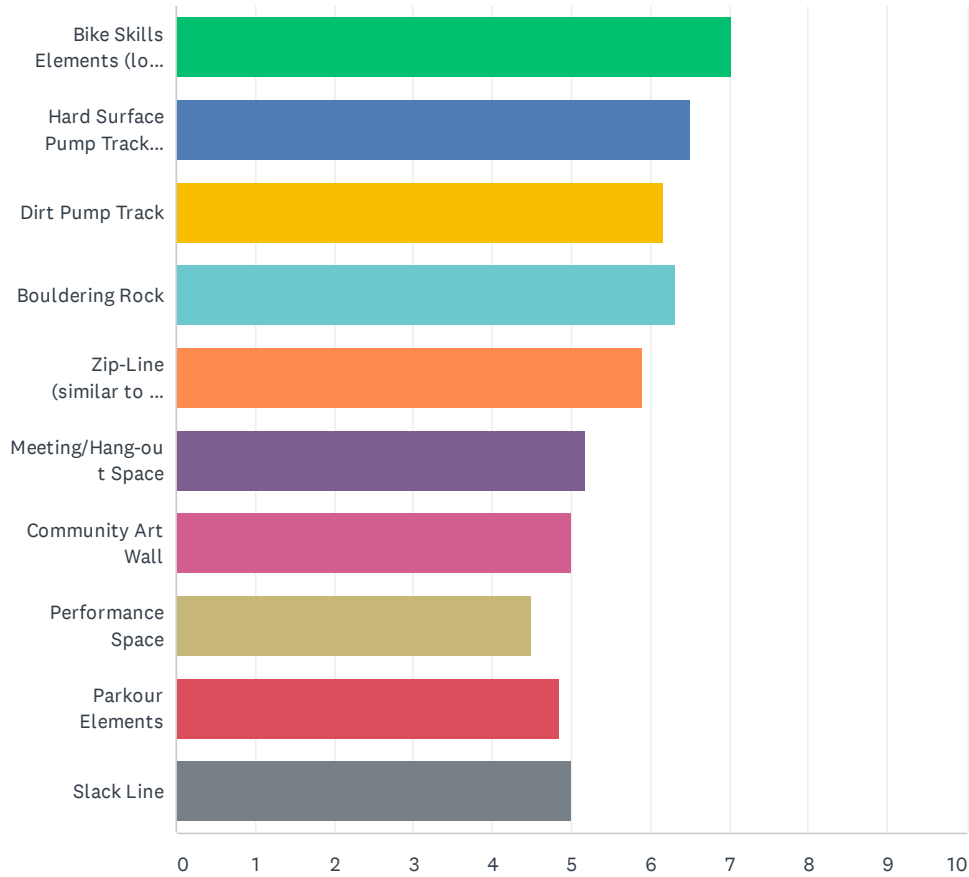
