Issues from order:

Fire Services Act Section 21(a):	The premises are in a state of disrepair that a fire starting in them might spread rapidly to endanger life or other property.
Fire Services Act Section 21(c):	A fire hazard exists on the premises.

The Saanich Fire Department attended Regina Park and issued an Order related to the following fire hazard(s) / unacceptable life safety conditions, contrary to the Fire Services Act and/or District of Saanich bylaws.

INSIDE TENTS/STRUCTURES

1. Inside Tents/Structures

- a. No open flames whatsoever are permitted inside tents or structures. This includes open flame heating, lighting and cooking appliances, candles, matches, and cigarette lighters.
- b. No flammable liquids, flammable or compressed gases, or any other flammable materials shall be brought into, used or stored inside tents or structures.
- c. No portable generators or any other equipment capable of discharging carbon monoxide shall be brought into, used or stored inside tents or structures.
- d. Cooking inside tents or structures is prohibited.
- e. Smoking of any kind inside tents or structures is prohibited.

2. Outside Tents/Structures

- All tents and structures must be separated from one another by not less than one (1) metre of open space. (*Multiple tents in multiple locations are positioned directly next to* each other)
- All tents and structures must be arranged and oriented to maintain a clear path of egress from each tent or structure to a safe area. (*Multiple tents in multiple locations do not have a clear path of egress)*
- c. No tent or structure shall be covered by a tarpaulin or other covering material, unless it is a tarpaulin certified as non-flammable by the manufacturer. A certified non-flammable tarpaulin shall be used to cover one (1) tent or structure only, and must not be used to

cover more than one (1) tent or structure. (Non- certified Tarpaulins are covering multiple tents in multiple locations)

- d. All flammable liquids, flammable or compressed gases, and any other flammable materials must be stored at least three (3) metres away from any tent or structure, and any refueling of heating, lighting, cooking or other appliances must be done at least three (3) metres away from any tent or structure.
- e. All open flame appliances must be used and stored downwind from, and at least three (3) metres away from any tent or structure, and must be fully extinguished when not in use.
- f. Portable generators and any other equipment capable of discharging carbon monoxide must be used and stored at least one (1) metre away from tents or structures, and must be positioned in such a manner as to prevent the accumulation of carbon monoxide in or near tents or structures.

3. <u>Other</u>

- a) No smoking in the Park.
- b) Tall grass that has been cut must be removed.
- c) Tents shall not be placed within (3) metres of a fence or structure.
