#### Supply List:

Please bring to the first class:

#### Required:

- A silkscreen – can be purchased individually from Opus or in a kit at Opus or Island Blue. Bear in mind when you choose your screen, that your image-making area will be approximately 2 inches smaller than the inside dimension of the screen frame.
- A squeegee – Choose a squeegee that will fit within the frame of your screen. A couple of inches shorter than the width is perfect. If you do not want to splash out on a wooden handled squeegee, a simple plastic one is fine, or in a pinch you can even use a firm shower squeegee from a hardware store.
- An apron or clothes you do not mind getting permanently inky.

#### Recommended:

These supplies will be available to use, but it is often beneficial to have your own. Please note that white 90lb paper will be available to purchase from the Arts Centre. Screen printing ink will be provided.

- Rubber gloves for clean up.
- Packing tape – This will be provided, but it is nice to have your own. I prefer tan coloured (Castle building supply).
- Old plastic gift/membership cards - These make great ink scrapers for clean up.
- Sketchbook, pencil
- Exacto knife
- Shelf liner (E.g. mactac) for making stencils
- A fine paintbrush
- Things you want to print on, for example paper, greeting cards, t-shirts, bags, book covers. This will be discussed further in the first class.
