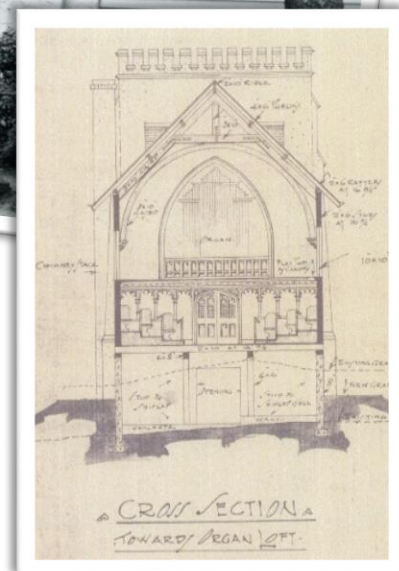
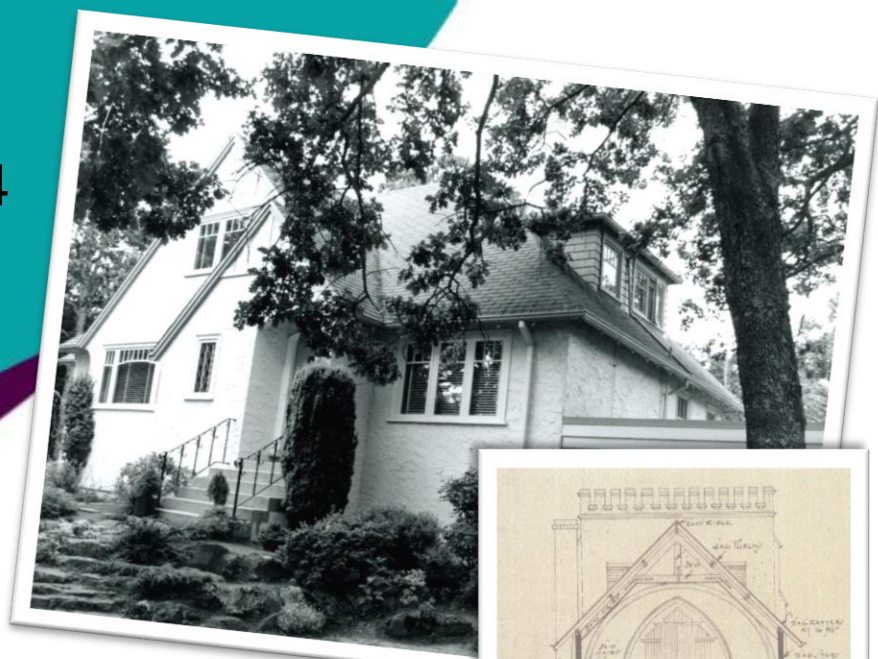


EXHIBIT: BUILDING SAANICH
